While mandatory disclosure may reduce investment-q-sensitivity hence lower managerial learning (Jayaraman and Wu (2019)), I find that voluntary disclosure could increase such sensitivity. This shows that managers will use such disclosure to improve the information environment and allure traders to seek more information relating to the firm, which can then be learned by managers through stock prices. A possible channel also leading to the sensitivity change is ruled out by subsamples without increased financing. I also find a decrease in investment-q-sensitivity when the disclosed information deviates from the real numbers. These findings have not been documented before and broaden the knowledge of voluntary disclosure in the field of accounting.
