Résumé and work history

When making admission decisions, we consider work experience to include both internships and/or post-baccalaureate experience. The quality and quantity of experience, combined with career goals, are equally evaluated. Your decision to pursue graduate study should be consistent with the career goals typically offered for this program.

Two required essays (250–500 words)

Essays help us to learn more about you and your career goals. They allow candidates to highlight examples of their professional capabilities, leadership qualities, and talents in working with diverse teams.

College transcripts

We seek candidates committed to academic excellence. We evaluate all undergraduate and graduate coursework that has been completed prior to applying. Specific review of business, accounting, and math grades are considered in addition to your cumulative GPA. Applicant concerns on any dimension of the academic profile may be addressed in the application and personal interview.

School-issued official transcripts should be scanned and uploaded for each college attended. Please provide all transcripts—both from undergraduate and graduate school (if applicable).

GMAT, GRE, or Executive Assessment scores*

Standardized test scores support your application and provide an assessment of verbal, quantitative, and analytical skills. We recommend taking the GMAT or GRE to demonstrate your quantitative capabilities if you have limited exposure to math or business courses.

Official test taker copy/score report for GMAT or GRE (including analytical writing assessment, if applicable) or your official test taker copy for the Executive Assessment should be scanned and uploaded.

* Options are available to waive the GMAT/GRE requirement for admission. Contact the admissions team to learn more.

Letter of Recommendation

As part of the online application, you will be asked to supply contact information for one contact who can provide a letter of recommendation. Ideally, this person would be a supervisor or professional contact who can speak to your strengths, career accomplishments, and goals.

Application fee

The non-refundable application fee is \$100 US dollars and can be paid by credit card within the online application. Applications are incomplete until payment is received. Some applicants may qualify for an application fee waiver. Please contact Admissions for more information.
